To the County Auditors of Minnesota:

The following is the notice of federal and state offices that will be voted for at the state general election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. The filing period for United States Senator (term ending January 3, 2025), United States Senator (term ending January 3, 2021), United States Representative, State Representative, Minnesota Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, Attorney General, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of the Minnesota Court of Appeals, and Judge of the District Court begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 22, 2018, and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 5, 2018.

Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 28, 2018, in observance of Memorial Day.

The place of filing for federal offices is the Office of the Secretary of State, State Office Building, Room 180, 100 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., St. Paul, MN 55155-1299. The place of filing for state offices is with the Office of the Secretary of State or with the county auditor of the county in which the candidate resides.

Candidates may file in person or by mail, if the filing is received during the filing period. Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09, subdivision 1a, may arrange to file during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state.

This notice is provided pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 204B.33.
