CAMPAIGN SIGNS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ANY STATE HIGHWAY.



CAMPAIGN SIGNS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ANY CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.



CAMPAIGN SIGNS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON PRIVATE LAND WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT, ON PUBLIC UTILITY POLES, ON TREES OR SHRUBS, AND BY PAINTING OR DRAWING ON ROCKS OR NATURAL FEATURES.



POLITICAL SIGNS SHALL BE PERMITTED ON EACH LOT FOR A PERIOD OF <u>SIXTY (60) DAYS</u> PRIOR TO AND <u>TEN (10) DAYS</u> AFTER AN ELECTION.

FOR FULL REGULATIONS REGARDING CAMPAIGN SIGN PLACEMENT, PLEASE REFER TO MINNESOTA STATE STATUTES, MNDOT REGULATIONS, AND CITY OF INTERNATIONAL FALLS ORDINANCE SECTION 11-20.
